We must be very careful not to trump the truth of God with our traditions when it comes to symbols. At the same time, we must be very careful to properly observe those symbols which God has instructed us to observe in His Word.



This teaching should never produce a sense of mean-spirited dictatorship of men over women. We need to remember that we need one another.
